

REQUEST FOR LDST 491 COLLABORATIVE STUDY

Ollaborative study provides students with the opportunity to conduct research collaboratively with a Jepson faculty member on a project of theoretical or methodological importance to the faculty member's program of research. Collaborative study must involve more than providing research assistance to an ongoing project; rather, the student must take responsibility for conducting original research of scholarly value. Collaborative study will be grounded in rigorous methods appropriate to the discipline in which the student is working and will culminate in a final product. The project must be sponsored by a faculty mentor and approved by the associate dean for academic affairs by the end of the two-week add/drop period for the semester in which the study is to take place. Students are expected to spend at least 10 hours per week on work related to the course.
