

Application for Jepson Summer Research Grant/Fellowship

Please submit this application via email to chair of Scholarship Committee.

The purpose of a full Summer Research Fellowship is to permit the researcher to work on the funded project for the entire summer. When making its recommendations to the dean, the scholarship committee will give priority to applications that meet the following criteria:

- 1. The proposal shows the promise of publication, or contributes to course development or other aspects of the mission of the Jepson School.
- 2. The researcher demonstrates scholarly output, or progress towards scholarly output, from previous summer grants.
- 3. Researchers who are not employed full time in the summer or are the recipients of a substantial outside grant for their work.
- 4. Meets the grant proposal deadline of **April 14**.

Prior to the award of Summer Research support, the Dean will review applications to assure they are consistent with faculty members' scholarship portfolios as stated in their annual reviews, which give an overall account of their scholarship portfolio, including components directly related to leadership and leadership processes and components addressing other aspects of a faculty member's field.
